A person selected shall have no enforceable right against the University for continuation in the succeeding academic session in any circumstances.**
- A person selected will be permissible to avail only 8 general leave during the academic session. No other leave and allowances are permitted to the person selected.
- Candidates must read all the instructions before filling the application form in a prescribed "Format of Application" from the University website www.nagpuruniversity.ac.in Candidates must ensure that no column is wrongly filled in Application form as the information furnished therein would be used for deciding the eligibility and suitability of the candidates appearing for the interview.
